<u>Proposal No. 2010-01:</u> Defining codes for online and direct access electronic resources in 008/23 and 008/29 (Form of item)

Source: Program for Cooperative Cataloging

Summary: This paper proposes making code "s" electronic obsolete in 008/23 and 008/29 (Form of item). It proposes defining new codes in character positions 008/23 and 008/29 (Form of item) for online and direct access electronic resources.

<u>Proposal No. 2010-02</u> Addition of subfield \$5 (Institution to which field applies) in the 80X-830 Series Added Entry Fields of the MARC 21 Bibliographic Format

Summary: This paper proposes the addition of subfield \$5 in fields 800, 810, 811, and 830, for use in recording the name of a digital collection as a series in records for local or

regional digital preservation projects, and projects of wider scope such as the Registry of Digital Masters (RDM). The data would indicate to which institution the series applies in records that are part of the registry or other digital preservation projects, where the institution makes a commitment to preserve digital masters.

Summary: This paper proposes defining subfield \$3 (Materials specified) in field 034 (Coded Cartographic Mathematical Data) of the MARC 21 Bibliographic and Authority Formats as follows: \$3 - Materials specified (NR): Information that specifies the part of the entity to which the field applies.
